

Executive Summary

Chartered Accountancy Academy (CAA) is excited to offer the Bachelor of Science Honours Degree in Professional Accounting (BSPA), the first of its kind in Zimbabwe. This program is specially designed to match the standards needed to become a Chartered Accountant, helping to improve the training of accountants in the country. The course follows a framework used by top accounting bodies in Zimbabwe and South Africa, focusing on practical skills and real-world knowledge. It also meets international standards for accounting education, making sure students are fully prepared for the job market.



Pathway to Chartered Accountant Zimbabwe

Students will be eligible to register for the Zimbabwe Certificate in Theory of Accounting (ZCTA). A holder of the BSPA will be eligible to join either the full-time CTA program or part-time program for a duration of one year.

Purpose

This qualification aims to give students a strong education in accounting that includes both technical skills and important soft skills like communication and leadership. It helps students learn to take initiative and be responsible, setting them up to become future leaders. The program is designed to prepare students for a career as a Chartered Accountant more quickly than other accounting degrees in Zimbabwe. It covers all the key knowledge and skills needed to succeed in the profession and allows students to apply what they learn to real-world situations. The degree also opens the door to further studies in related fields.

Entry Requirements

- 5 subjects at Ordinary Level including Mathematics and English.
- At least two subjects at 'A' Level including Accounting or Mathematics or any other commercial subject.
- This means students studying science subjects at A' level can switch and enroll for this course so long they are studying mathematics.

Mature Entry

- At least 23 years (females) and 25 years (males) on the first day of the academic year in which admission is sought.
- 5 subjects at Ordinary Level incl. Maths and English.
- Relevant working experience of at least 2 years.
- Candidates must attend interviews and/or special tests at the University to evaluate their English language proficiency, numeracy, reasoning ability, and overall suitability for program admission.

How does it work

- The BSPA is a 4-year part time program which encompasses the academic side (Lectures) and practical training;
- The lectures are conducted over the **weekends** to cater for the practical training which will be on going during **week days.**
- The mode of lecture delivery is a blended learning approach entailing both Online lectures and physical contact sessions The BSPA exams are physically written at the CAA InnovateU Campus (200 Upper east Mount Pleasant, Harare)

Practical Experience

- No separate year for attachment, students gain experience through articles.
- Students will need to complete a set of pre-defined work activities which are picked from the ICAZ articles program.
- The experience will be gained at the same time as the academic studies.
